

The Utilities Commission (UC) offers several convenient ways to manage your account:

### **Budget Billing**

The Budget Billing Program allows you to budget your expenses easier by paying a monthly average of your regular utility bills. A true-up occurs at the end of the calendar year. This program is available to year-round customers who pay their bills via Automatic Utility Bill Pay (below) and who have had service for a minimum of nine months at the location.

### **Automatic Utility Bill Pay**

The Automatic Utility Bill Pay Program allows you to pay your monthly UC bill directly from your bank account on the due date shown on your statement. It's a great way to avoid late fees, and is especially helpful for part-time residents.

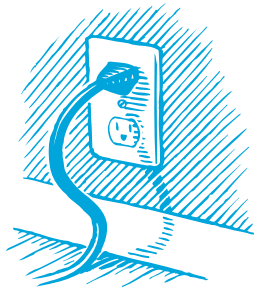
As always, payments are also accepted via mail, via the UC drive-thru and night drop, or by stopping at the UC office at 200 Canal St.
