

Conservation Programs

Energy Conservation

In addition to free energy audits for our residential and small business customers, the Utilities Commission has several other programs to encourage energy and water conservation, which can help you save on your utility bill while doing your part to conserve our natural resources.

Residential Rebates:

Window Solar Screen	up to a \$375 credit
Duct Leak Repair	up to a \$200 credit
Added Insulation	up to a \$375 credit

Commercial Rebates:

LED EXIT Sign	up to \$75 credit for each existing exit sign replaced (max. 5 per location)
Window Solar Screen	up to a \$375 credit (non-demand commercial only)
Duct Leak Repair	up to a \$200 credit (non-demand commercial only)
Added Insulation	up to a \$375 credit (non-demand commercial only)

Load Management:

Upon signing up for this program, the UC will install a load management receiver on your major electric appliances, namely the central air/heat unit, and/or the water heater. This is a radio controlled unit which

enables us to shut off your appliances for a few minutes during certain time intervals. Most people do not even notice that load management is in use. In exchange, we credit your electric bill for up to \$7.50 per month, or \$90 per year.

Water Conservation

Showerhead Exchange:

Our showerhead exchange program offers UC water customers the opportunity to exchange their old 2.5 gpm showerhead for a water-saving kit, which includes a 1.25 gpm massaging showerhead and other conservation tools. See our Customer Service staff to pick up your free showerhead today.

Water-wise Demonstration Garden:

UCNSB, in partnership with Lindley's Nursery & Garden Center, sponsors a Water-Wise Demonstration Garden in the parking lot of the UCNSB downtown New Smyrna Beach office at 200 Canal Street. It is part of our continuing efforts to encourage water conservation in the landscape.

The garden, designed and maintained by Lindley's, features over 25 plants, shrubs and trees that are well-suited for a Southeast Volusia County landscape.

The plants included in the design are either native to Florida or Florida-friendly. These plants require only occasional water once established. Most are cold tolerant, have low maintenance needs and are not susceptible to insects or diseases.
