F.O.G. is an acronym for the fats, oils and grease that is found in common food and food ingredients such as meat, fish, butter, cooking oil, mayonnaise, gravies, sauces and food scraps.

DO NOT DISPOSE OF F.O.G. IN ANY SINK DRAIN OR TOILET !

When poured down the drain or flushed down a toilet, F.O.G. hardens into a clog , which leads to sewer back-ups into homes or businesses.

These clogs in private lateral lines can lead to costly plumbing repairs, not to mention a nasty mess to clean up.

F.O.G. in wastewater mains is also a costly and preventable repair.

Scrape all remaining food scraps from plates, pots and pans. Soak up remaining F.O.G. with a paper towel. Or you can pour cooled F.O.G. into a disposable container and throw it away when full.
