UCNSB will consider the rate changes during the Regular Meeting on August 23, 2021, in the DeBerry Room, 200 Canal Street, New Smyrna Beach.

As your trusted utility advisor, UCNSB has been proud to maintain low rates while providing safe and reliable service. This was achieved through cost containment, use of cash reserves, and deferment of non-essential capital improvement projects. To ensure we can fund the necessary improvements to provide the long term reliability and resiliency of the UC's infrastructure, outside consultants performed a rate study.

The rate study results show minor modifications are essential. Currently, we have the lowest residential electric rates in Florida, and our water rates are consistently among the lowest in Central Florida. As your community partner, we have kept rates low, despite increases in the cost of doing business. We remain committed to this effort.
